

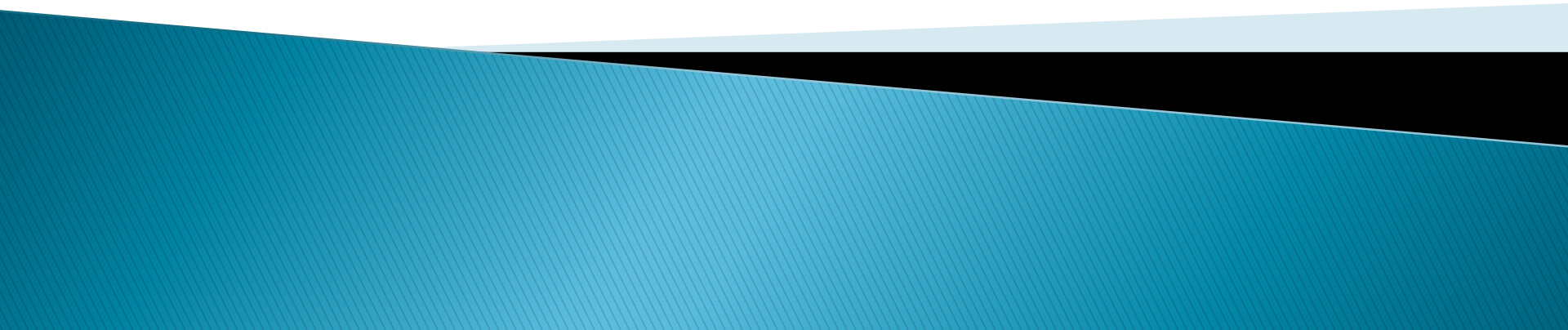

Approval of October Minutes

GOLF ADVISORY COMMITTEE MINUTES

October 19, 2020

Present: Chris Sykes, Howard Higby, Rose Howard, Craig Andrews, Daryl Blevins, Kristin Farrington, Well McClure, Jon North, and Larry Fox.

Absent: Ron Coles

The meeting was called to order by Howard Higby at 3:30 PM

The minutes of the September meeting were approved unanimously.

Rounds Report

Chris Sykes reported that September was another very busy month.

Rounds for the month were 3,191 over budget. Total rounds year to date are 16,889 over budget.

Revenue Report

September was also another great month for Revenue. Gross Profit for the month was \$98,202.83 over budget. Expense for September were \$44,261.45 over budget due mainly to timing of some expenses. Year to date expenses are under budget.

Capital Requests

Capital requests for 2021 have been finalized, there are sixteen items which total \$987,000. The major items being \$210,000 to replace the golf carts at Kahite, \$50,000 to Replace the cart batteries at Tanasi and \$250,000 to replace and renovate the front nine bunkers at Kahite.

2021 GOLF RATES

Chris then reported back to the committee the comments by the Finance Committee and the POA on the proposed golf rates for 2021.

The main areas of comment dealt with the Afternoon Unlimited Rate, and the Unlimited Family Golf Rate. The gist of the comments is that these rates needed to be increased.

After some discussion a motion was made by Rose Howard, seconded by Daryl Blevins to offer an unlimited cart option in addition to the afternoon unlimited golf for \$400.00 This motion passed unanimously.

As to the Family Unlimited after discussion a motion was made by Craig Andrews, seconded by Daryl Blevins to increase the Unlimited Family rate to \$3500.00 This rate would include unlimited range use. This motion also passed unanimously.

However, Family members would still have the option of paying \$3200.00 with no driving range.

The data provided by Chris through Adam Jacobs showed that the second person with some exceptions played approximately one-half the number of rounds of the main player.

Golf Events Update.

The Folds of Honor event was a great success raising just under \$10,000.

The Men's Member Guest is scheduled for October 21-24. The Ladies Leagues end on November 3rd. The Turkey shoot is scheduled for Nov.14th and the Santa Claus Open is Scheduled for December 5th.

The Covid-19 protocols are still in place and there have been no real problems to date.

Golf Course Updates

All three courses are preparing for winter. Over the winter all three courses will be completing projects. The cart path on #11 at Tanasi has been repaired and should reopen shortly. Three additional bunkers will be done in Jan-Feb. The Kahite Bunker fill-in have been completed and have come in nicely. The new natural areas to the right of holes 12 and 14 are coming along.

Sam Whitted has been appointed Asst. Supt. At Tanasi. Congratulation Sam

Other Business

The Marketing Department has some new articles on all three courses which will appear in the next newsletter.

The Handicap Committee will be reviewing the soft Cap Rule on the new Handicap System.

New Stop Signs are being ordered for Kahite. The Golf calendar and Website continue to be worked on.

The meeting adjourned at 4:48 PM

Tellico Village Golf Operations Update – 5/31/2020

First and foremost, we want to thank the entire golf community for keeping golf a safe haven in Tellico Village.

We are excited to announce the Board of Directors has approved **Phase 2 COVID-19 Golf Operations, which will go into effect on Monday, June 1st**. The primary changes are related to Golf Shop operations and golf carts.

Golf Shop Operations

We will be reopening the golf shop lobbies for check-in and retail shopping in adherence with state guidelines.

- We ask that you stay home if you have any COVID-19 symptoms or have been exposed to anyone with COVID-19 in the last 14-days.
- We encourage everyone to check-in via the golf shop, but we will still be able to process via telephone.
- As a convenience and social distancing precaution, all league play will be automatically checked-in prior to your round unless you cancel in advance.
- Traffic flow – please enter the golf shop through the main clubhouse entrance and exit through the golf shop side door.
- Social Distancing – please abide by all postings and placards.
- We will continue to disinfect all touch points. Sanitizing stations are available at all locations.
- Golf shop merchandise will continue to be marketed via social media and on the www.golftellicovillage.com.
- Golf shop purchases can be made online or via telephone with delivery options available.



Golf Carts

- We have fabricated and installed a barrier system in the golf carts so we can most effectively and safely return to two-persons per cart. **These dividers can be pinned up or rolled up for storage; please see a member of the golf staff to adjust up or down.**
- Two persons per cart will lead to more tee time availability and therefore a greater likelihood of fulfilling tee time requests.
- We will also continue to afford the option of a solo cart for a modest surcharge of \$5 per nine holes.
 - Carts are still first come first serve.
 - Private carts are exempt.
 - Does not apply to second cart in a threesome.
- We will continue to disinfect golf carts prior to use. Divot bottles and scorecards will be placed back on the golf carts and disinfected accordingly.



Additional

- Shotgun starts – guidelines now allow for groups of up to 50 persons so we will carefully bring back shotgun starts taking social distancing into consideration.
- Range balls – we will be shifting back to a token system to be placed in baskets, all of which will be disinfected between users.
- All non-essential items will remain off the golf course to remove any unnecessary touch points for the time being.



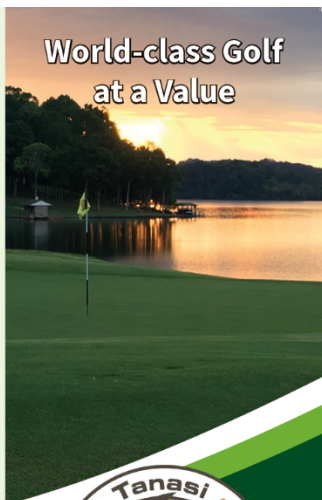

World-class Golf at a Value



Tellico Village is home to three of the most beautiful and challenging championship golf courses in East Tennessee. All three courses were designed by the prestigious firm of Ault, Clark, and Associates, architects of some of America's greatest courses.

TOQUA GOLF COURSE

Toqua is a beautiful golf course cut through a forest on Tellico Lake. You have everything from tree-lined holes to a links setting on the lake. The genius of the course is that it is playable for all levels of golfers.

The Toqua course offers a driving range, short-game practice area and practice putting green. It has a brand-new clubhouse that opened in 2019, as well as a pavilion that is used for tournaments, banquets, and other large gatherings and events. The new clubhouse features a Golf Pro Shop and sports bar-themed restaurant that provides a spacious veranda for post-play food and refreshments.

Toqua has hosted numerous Tennessee Golf Association events—including the 2005 Senior Amateur Championship, the 2009, 2011 and 2018 Four-Ball Championships and the 2009, 2011, and

2017 Senior Four-Ball Championships—as well as the 2008, 2009, and 2010 PGA Tour Nationwide Knoxville Open Qualifier.

TANASI GOLF COURSE

Tanasi was the second of the Tellico Village courses to open. It has a fun and contemporary layout that winds through the Tanasi neighborhood, and even has some holes that run over and alongside parts of Tellico Lake.

Tanasi offers options for players of all ages and skillsets, as well as a selection of tees to best fit your game. Our Black Championship tees measure 6,731 yards, while our yellow tees offer a fun short course at 4,486 yards. Tanasi is a fun course to play with wide fairways, large flat landing areas and big undulating greens.

Tanasi also has an expansive putting green with large undulations that mimic the greens you will encounter throughout the golf course. The Tanasi Clubhouse includes an excellent restaurant that offers casual dining with beautiful views of Tellico Lake. The wrap-around porch invites you to relax and enjoy the spectacular lake and golf course view while you dine.

THE LINKS AT KAHITE

Opened in 2002, the Links at Kahite is Tellico Village's hidden gem in Vonore, TN. The golf course is surrounded by Tellico Lake and offers breathtaking, panoramic views of the Great Smoky Mountains. It sits on over 200 acres of property and offers a variety of turfgrass species that adds difficulty and beauty on every hole. Kahite has six sets of tees that play from 7,170 yards to 4,435 yards to provide a variety of options and difficulty while making the experience fun and challenging.

Kahite features a practice facility that includes a driving range and practice putting green. The Kahite Pub & Grill offers casual dining and an outdoor patio with a great view.

In 2003, the Links at Kahite was nominated by Golf Digest as best new private course and has since hosted many Tennessee Golf Association events, including the 2009 and 2011 Four-Ball and Senior Four-Ball Championships, as well as the 2009 and 2010 PGA Tour Nationwide Open Qualifier.
