2023 Golf Operations Budget Summary

Objective:

- Increase the property value for golfers <u>and</u> non-golfers at Tellico Village, through:
 - High quality golf course conditions, appropriate for the membership at Tellico Village
 - Attractive fee structure for members and guests of members
 - Continued improvement of sustainability of golf courses
 - Adherence to budget guidance of the POA Board of Directors

BUDGET ASSUMPTIONS

- Fee Adjustments Proposed for 2023
 - MEMBER RATES INCREASED 5% ACROSS THE BOARD
 - GUEST RATES INCREASED AVERAGE OF 11.5%
 - PREPAID DISCOUNT REMAINS AT 5%
 - INCREASE INDIVIDUAL ANNUAL BREAKEVEN 5 ROUNDS (85 NOW)
 - INCREASE TWO-PERSON HOUSEHOLD ANNUAL BREAKEVEN 10 ROUNDS (130 NOW)
 - SHOTGUN EVENTS THAT REQUIRE A GOLF COURSE BLOCK PAY BEFORE 2 PM RATES
 - OUTSIDE EVENT OUTINGS ANNUAL PACKAGES NO LONGER INCLUDED IN OUTSIDE EVENT PRICING
 - TWILIGHT PACKAGES AFTER 2 PM EVERY DAY

2023 Golf Operations Forecasting Golf Revenue



Rounds of golf are not the biggest variable in forecasting golf revenue.



Revenue per round (YIELD) is the biggest variable in forecasting golf revenue.

Example:

- Under budget by 1,000 rounds at forecasted revenue per round of \$41.03 equals a revenue shortfall of \$41,030
- Under budget by \$2.00 per round but meeting forecasted rounds of 100,000 equals a revenue shortfall of \$200,000 (Annuals increase this amount)

Kahite Golf Maintenance Updates

- Weather History September '23:
 - August GAC 16.5" last 2 months
 - 0.2" Rain Total September
 - 2 .1" rain events
 - 0" in September 2019
 - Conclusion:
 - Bentgrass greens are ideal for fall playing conditions
 - Grooming
 - Bermudagrass is great inside our irrigation loop
 - Outside the loop is experiencing drought conditions heading into Winter play.
 - Golf Course looks incredible down with the brown!





Kahite Golf Maintenance Updates

- October = Bermuda Encroachment month
 - Blitz season long encroachment activity.
 Important to move quickly as Bermuda is shutting down and bentgrass is thriving
 - Plugwork inside green
 - Square, Hex, 2", Cup Cutter
 - Setup guys trained to avoid cutting and transplanting Bermuda across entire green
 - Sodwork along edges of green
 - Most aggressive area of encroachment. Sodwork is much more efficient.
 - Helps maintain our current square footage.
 - Experiment with Greens edging in summer '24
 - Possible chemical control/strategy on the market (Carolina GCS)
 - Currently, researching results and standard of procedures.







Kahite Golf Maintenance Updates

- Other Activities/Improvements
 - 6 more Hole signs completed
 - Look to finish January '24
 - Ryegrass Driving Range Tee open for play
 - Avoid mats
 - Play on Turf all fall/winter
 - Protects Bermuda underneath
 - Quarterly Sand Depth Check completed
 - Last check of the year December
 - Bunkers performing perfectly/still protected
 - Look to put final fly-mow end of Oct.
 - New Natural area expansion behind #2 Green is seeded and popping already
 - Afforded us a lot of bermudagrass to help patch up weak areas
 - Spring Dead Spot Application
 - 1st app is down/2nd app due end of October
 - Poa Pre-emergent is right around the corner









Fall Applications

- All courses have received their fall fertilizer with potassium to give us a little growth and help prepare our Bermuda for winter dormancy
- Heights of cut have been raised and will go up slightly more before we are done mowing for the year
- All courses have made Spring Dead Spot and Large Patch applications. Timing based on soil temperatures
- Poa annua pre/post emerge applications starting next week.
 Again based off soild temperature.



September was very dry. Only .75" for the month

- Greens have healed in great from Dryject.
- Heights are back down where we want them and speed is perfect.
- As cooler temps arrive growth will slow and speeds will continue to increase
- We will do our best to monitor green speeds and keep them within our acceptable range



Staff

- All full time positions at Tanasi and Toqua have been filled.
- Full time seasonal staff are done for the year
- Our villager staff will continue to help us out a couple days a week and on the weekends through leaf season.

Seeding

- All new natural areas have been seeded as well as some old areas at toqua that are to be renovated.
- Ryegrass seed at Toqua and Tanasi has been put down on clubhouse lawn areas.
- Some shady tees at Toqua have been seeded
- Both driving range tees at Toqua have been seeded to hopefully help these small undersized tees out through the winter and early spring

Fall/Winter Cart Traffic

- Some holes will be switching to CPO at all three courses to protect our vulnerable turf areas from cart traffic. These holes have either north facing slopes, concentrated entry and exits, bottle necks or shade concerns that prevent our Bermuda from recovering.
- It is imperative we protect these areas through the fall, winter and early spring if we want decent turf to play off of next summer.
- This past spring the talk of the town was how slow some areas were to green up and fill in. This was the direct result of the hard freeze last Christmas and the barrage of cart traffic that followed through the spring.
